### Transitional Arrangements - Examination Completion Requirements

All students who registered before the March 2010 examination diet must complete all outstanding examinations in the new ACS qualification scheme within eight years from April 1, 2010. The period that elapsed before March 2010 examination diet will not be counted.

Students will not be allowed to take a mixture of Level 1 and 2 examinations at the same examination session. All examination papers in Level 1 must be completed before attempting Level 2 examinations.
